EVENTS: Primitive sights only (no fiber optics). Wood bows and arrows only. Please fill out your score cards and turn them in before 5:00 p.m. on Saturday at the Registration Booth. If turned in late, your scores will not be counted. Please fill out your score cards honestly. Archery, Rifle and Pistol shooters, please make your group no less than 3 and no more than 5 to make things run smoother. **Fees:** \$15 per shooter or \$30 per family (immediate family under 18 only). Fees cover all Four Events. **Youth:** 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult! Look for details at the Registration Tent.

RULES: Adults, children and animals that are out of line or engaging in unsafe activities (i.e. shooting in camp, causing trouble, or any vulgarity) will be asked to leave. Please no Ground Pounders (Noise Makers).

CAMPING: There will be a hand cart provided for those who need to load or unload in the primitive camping area after these times. **Fees:** \$10 per camp for both Primitive and Tin Tipi.

Long Term and Short Term Primitive Camping: In the Spirit of the Rendezvous: 1840's or earlier shelter and accoutrements. No visible plastic and paper items (jugs, coolers, cups, plates, etc....) No vehicles allowed in this area Friday 8 a.m. - Sunday 12 p.m.

Tin Tipi Camping: 1840's up to present shelter and accoutrements. Please be courteous to your neighbors.
