Guy welcomed everyone to the meeting.

APPROVAL OF JANUARY MINUTES

Ray made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mike seconded the motion. All were in favor.

BOATING PROGRAM UPDATE

Rule dealing with dealer demo registrations R651-213-1 will take out the DMV as an agent. Parks will now that this over.

Betsy and Maciej were both approved by the Parks Board.

CARRYING PASSENGERS FOR HIRE

Tim has concerns about some of the CPFH rules.

First is being able to carry a photo copy or even have a photo on their phone, of their guide license and/or boat crew permit like they can with their first aid and CPR cards. Ty would

like to have Tim write up a proposed wording for this rule. Tim will get something together and will send out an email to the Council to vote on.

Next is the language for the first aid requirements. American Red Cross or Emergency Response courses are very hard to find anymore. Small committee together with Tim, Brody Tony White, or any Division ER instructors to look at the federal standards with DOT to stream line the first aid and CPR standards.

Captain/Guide license with standard first aid resorts back to boat crew permit, should put it in writing.

Type 4 language confusing and not appropriate on rivers throw bag vs cushion, we need to look at federal regulations to make sure we stay in compliance with them.

Type 3 instead of Type 1 or 5, the USCG is looking into a national realm of pfd classifications. Ty suggested to maybe waiting until we see what happens with the new classification.

Use of pack rafts, side stream to major river, pfd requirements for an inflatable on rivers, we need to look to see if there is a manual deploy jacket that is an approved inflatable for use on rivers.

AIS OPERATIONS

Lake Powell is infested. NPS only has a resource protection budget, once listed as infested NPS has no money. Glen Canyon Rec Area has no budget for AIS, greet boats as they come off the water educate them with clean, drain or dry. Any visible mussels cannot leave Lake Powell without being decontaminated.

BOATING ACCESS GRANTS UPDATE

Ty showed the Council what grants were approved and accepted letters have been sent out. Spreadsheet is on file.
