The Council and the rowers had a discussion on whether or not rowing, paddling, sailing and stand up paddle clubs are considered carrying passengers for hire. Since these clubs are charging for their services, these clubs fall under leading passengers for hire.

The Council all agreed that the current tests in place need to be redone. Should there be a test for motorized, non-motorized, lakes, rivers, etc? What does a guide, captain, coach need to know? They created a subcommittee of six members, Brody Young, Tim Gaylord, Betsy Risner, Irene Lysenko, Ty Hunter and Ty will contact Maciej Mamon if he will be interested to represent sailing.

First aid and CPR requirements should be changed as well. There should be a basic standard across the board.

The carrying passengers for hire program should be streamlined and easy for users to understand and follow. Laws and rules should be easy to follow and understand as well. The program should also have a mission statement.
