

A High-Tech Treasure Hunt

We used tree-ring dating to find out just how old our ponderosa pines really are. In fact, some are very old! These trees have been here and growing while much of the world's modern history was in the making.

Use your GPS device to find these trees and discover what was happening at the time each tree began to grow.

Sand Dune Safety

Please take care on your history trek. While a shorter hike is available, both trails can be strenuous. There is no designated path and the sand is deep and soft. Stay safe by following a few tips:

- Carry plenty of water
- Don't overexert yourself and know when to turn back
- Pay attention to landmarks
- Be prepared

Finally, we ask that you please avoid stepping on vegetation and respect the trees you find. Do not disturb wildlife and be considerate of other visitors in the park.



