Vendor agrees to all rules set forth by the Presenter. It is the responsibility of each vendor to secure a booth and goods during the event and to ensure security during off hours.

Antelope Island State Park staff, at the recommendation of the Presenter, has the authority to remove a Vendor and any associated individuals from the grounds with cause, including unprofessional conduct. No refunds will be issued to Vendors asked to leave before the end of the program.

Vendor agrees to take responsibility for all business-related aspects of their booth, including carrying insurance, holding a business license, paying sales tax, obtaining food handler permits, or any other documentation, permits, or fees necessary to operate as a business in the State of Utah.

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
