Antelope Island's Cowboy Legends is a fantastic opportunity for vendors to kick off their summer! We have had over 10,000 people in attendance and that number continues to grow. We are specifically interested in vendors with western, cowboy/cowgirl, country, ranching, farming, or historic themed products. In addition, we select a few food vendors to provide high-quality food and drinks to our visitors.

Vendor fees are \$150 for a 10x10 booth or \$200 for a 10x20 booth. Included are two vehicle passes to enter Antelope Island State Park during the program and a campsite at the Fielding Garr Ranch field to cut down on your driving time (\$90 value).

- Set up is Friday, May 22 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm or Saturday, May 22, before 8:30 am. There is an evening show on Friday. You may choose to be open, but it is not required.
- Booths are expected to operate Saturday, Sunday, and Monday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

General Info

Power/Water: There is limited non-culinary water within the vendor area. Power is not provided and depending on the weather there may be park restrictions on generator use.

Vehicles: Vehicles are not permitted in the vendor area except during designated set up and take down times (exceptions may be made for food trucks). Daily dropoff and pickup of merchandise may be done in the area to the south and east of the vendor area before 9:00 am and after 5:00 pm. Vehicle traffic is not permitted near the vendor area during the day.

Weather: This is an outdoor event. Keep an eye on the weather as we get closer and plan accordingly. We have years with perfect weather and years with torrential rain. The show goes on as long as it is safe to do so.

Payments: Payment may be made by check or Venmo using the information on the application. Vendors are responsible for obtaining any permits or licenses and paying sales taxes. Menu prices may not be adjusted during the event.

Bugs: Bugs are also unpredictable, but generally not bad. If you wish to buy a mesh net, you will need to make sure it is specifically for No See Ums. Mosquito nets will not keep No See Ums out. Bug spray is recommended.
