

Yuba State Park Summer Employment Opportunity

Park Ranger Aide

Opening Date: January 1, 2020

Closing Date: March 20, 2020

Salary: \$9.49 per hour

Location: Yuba State Park

Time Frame: May through September

Positions available: 12 full or part time positions

The Utah Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, has seasonal positions (no benefits) available at Yuba State Park. This appointment will last from approximately May 11, 2020 to September 7, 2020, with possibility of extension. Students may work after school/weekends while school is in session.

Examples of Duties

Ranger Aides perform a variety of tasks including customer service, maintenance, janitorial, running zip lines, Aquatic Invasive Species (Quagga Mussel) interdiction, and assisting Rangers, among other duties.

Job Requirements and Skills

Applicant should have the ability to follow both oral and written instructions. Applicant should have the ability to perform general maintenance and grounds keeping tasks, using basic tools such as shovels, rakes, pruners, lawn mowers, etc. Applicant should have the ability to count change and take payment. Applicant should have the ability to clean restrooms and provide general park information to park visitors.

Other

Applicant must be willing to work independently in an outdoor setting, and work weekends and holidays. Work may require physical exertion. May require the ability to stand; walk over rough surfaces; bend, crouch, stoop, stretch, reach, lift moderately heavy items (up to 50 lbs.) in a recurring manner and/or for long periods of time. Applicant must be at least 16 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license and undergo a background check.
