Ceci's FREE Instructions:

What you'll need:

- scissors
- tape
- black construction paper (or white construction paper colored black)
- white paper
- markers, crayons, colored pencils, or anything else you would like to add as decoration!

- 1: Cut 2" strips of black construction paper
- 2: Measure the size of child's head using these strips, tape several together until desired size is achieved
- 3: Now cut six 1" strips of black construction paper, these will be your legs, as spiders have six legs!
- 4: Crimp (zig-zag) these strips. The folds do not need to be perfect
- 5: Attach the legs to the sides of the hat, leaving the front leg-free for us to place the eyes. This can be done using any sort of adhesive, but tape (or hot glue w/ adult supervision) is recommended
- 6: Using the white paper, cut out two large circles. Place a black dot within the center of each circle. These will be the spider's eyes (most spiders have eight eyes, so if you want to be scientifically accurate, go to town)!
- 7: Now attach these eyes to the front of your hat using your favorite adhesive, and your spider hat is complete
