- In some cases, insurance may be required. If needed, you will be asked to submit a copy of your Certificate of Insurance, with Antelope Island State Park, 4528 West 1700 So. Syracuse, Utah 84075 listed as an additional certificate holder.

Most photography/videography permits are \$60 and are good for 6 months.
