
## Desert Tortoise Week- October 4-8, 2021

Participate in our Desert Tortoise scavenger hunt and help us celebrate this iconic desert species. Find the following items and follow the instructions for each below:



- **Wildlife Crossing sign**. One of the main hazards for the desert tortoise and other resident wildlife is crossing the road safely. Locate a wildlife crossing sign in the park and, from a safe location, take a selfie with the sign.
- Desert holes and burrows. To escape the heat, tortoises and other resident wildlife seek out underground holes and burrows for shelter. Find a desert hole along a trail and observe its size and shape. On the back of this page, sketch your observations and write your ideas below on who might use this desert hole.
