APPRENTICE MAINTENANCE SPECIALIST

Salary: \$15.78 per hour depending upon experience and qualifications

The Utah Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks, has two (2) APPRENTICE MAINTENANCE SPECIALIST seasonal positions available at Bear Lake State Park near Garden City and Laketown, Utah. It is anticipated that this position will work 40 hours per week. Benefits are not provided. Housing options may be available.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Assist in the daily operations of Bear Lake State Park: perform general maintenance and upkeep of park buildings, facilities, grounds, and associated equipment; clean park restrooms and facilities; perform minor construction projects; may greet park visitors and provide customer service; and, perform other tasks as assigned.

JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS:

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older and possess a valid Utah Drivers License at time of employment. Applicants shall have the ability to operate a variety of grounds maintenance equipment. Applicants shall have the ability to work assigned shifts, which may include weekends, holidays, and nights. Applicants shall have the ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision in an outdoor recreation and tourism environment. Applicants must be able to competently operate a computer with Internet based programs.

Preference may be given to applicants with experience in: performance of maintenance, repairs, and upkeep of park facilities, equipment, and buildings; operation of various maintenance and grounds keeping equipment; possessing a Commercial Drivers License; work well with other people and provide customer service; and, education and/or schooling in a natural resource or parks and recreation related field.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must successfully pass a criminal history background check upon hire.
