

Jenny's Canyon

Trail Access: Jenny's Canyon Trailhead

Allowable Uses: Hiking

Distance: One-half mile (round trip)

Difficulty: Easy

Hiking Time: 20 minutes



Trail Description

From the signed trailhead, head east along the sandy trail towards the visible shrub-like trees and rock cliffs. When you reach the dry wash, cross directly and follow the trail until you reach a T-intersection at the base of the cliffs. From here, choose to go left into the slot canyon or right to climb up to a scenic overlook.

Special Features

The differential erosion rates of the sandstone make for amazing textures in the slot canyon walls. Look closely at the carved pockets higher in the slot. You may see signs of a nesting owl, raven or peregrine falcon. In spring, the approach to the slot canyon is flanked by bush penstemon and other colorful wildflowers.

Safety and Considerations

Portions of this trail feature deep sand or uneven rock surfaces. Wear suitable footwear.

Park Rules

- All hikers are required to stay on mapped trails.
- Dogs must be leashed. Scoop and dispose all waste.
- Day use hours are 6am-10pm.
- Writing or carving on rocks is prohibited.
