Park Information

General Information

- All vehicles must display a valid State Park pass while in the park
- Park hours: **6:00 A.M. – 10:00 P.M.** (Gates close at 10:00 P.M. – no entrance after hours)
- All vehicles must remain on the pavement;
- No Parking on Grass or Beach (not even for a second)
- Dogs must be on a maximum 6' leash and cleaned up after promptly
- Dogs are not allowed in the restrooms or visitor center

Camping Information

- Reservations may be made by calling 800.322.3770 or online at www.stateparks.utah.gov
- Each campsite may have 1 camping unit (RV, Trailer, Camper, Tent) with up to 8 occupants
- Quiet hours: 10:00 P.M. – 7:00 A.M. (generators must be turned off)
- Annual Passes are NOT valid for camping or as an extra vehicle pass

Extra Vehicle Information

- The vehicle must be paid for upon arrival, it is not included in the reservation
- The vehicle must display an extra vehicle permit (annual passes are not valid)
- The vehicle must fit on the pavement in the site without extending into the travel lane
- The vehicle must be a non-camping transportation vehicle
- Check in time – 3:00 P.M. Check out time – 12:00 P.M.

Cancellations & Refunds

- Refunds will not be issued for bad weather
- Site cancellations must be done through Reserve America and incur an \$8 cancellation fee
- Cancellations made 4 days or more in advance of arrival date (14 days for group sites) will result in a full refund minus the reservation & cancellation fee
- Cancellations made less than 4 days in advance of arrival date (14 days for group sites) will forfeit one night's fee in addition to the reservation and cancellation fee

Group Area

- The Group Site is a large grassy area with water, partial shade, a large open fire pit, volley ball net, large pavilion, with restrooms and showers
- The Group Site is available by reservation only, it cannot be booked day of
- The Group Site accommodates up to 100 people and 35 vehicles; There are no hook-ups for RVs

Boating Information

- All boaters must complete and display in the tow vehicle an invasive species certification form
- Boat limiting is based upon the capacity of the boat parking lot. When the parking lot is full, no additional boats will be allowed in the Park
- Boat trailer vehicles only in the marina parking lot on weekends and holidays, single vehicles must park in the single vehicle lot east of the boat ramp
