Desert Heat Can Kill!

Remember to prepare for your adventure and avoid heat emergency.

- Carry and Drink 1 liter (32oz) of water per person, per hour.
- Bring Salty Snacks or Electrolytes.
- Wear Sun Protection.
- Avoid Hotter Hours: Hike before 11am or after 7pm.

Seasonal Closures

Johnson Canyon is seasonally closed from March 15th until September 14th to protect sensitive habitat and breeding grounds.

Construction Updates

Our new south entrance booth and annual pass holder lane will be launching this summer! Utah Annual State Park pass or Snow Canyon Discovery pass holders, please be ready to present your pass to the gate attendant or kiosk for scanning.

Effective July 1, the new Whiterocks parking lot (which has been under construction since late March) will open to the public. Between June 23 and June 30 there will be no access to the Whiterocks amphitheater as the old lot is demolished and the new lot is being completed.

Snow Canyon will be participating in the Bryce Canyon Geology Festival July 18-19. Please visit Bryce Canyon National Park's official website for more information.

Ranger-led programs in the park are paused for the summer due to high temperatures. Check back in September when the weather starts to cool down!
