Snow Canyon Park Rules

- Follow the 25 mph posted speed limit.
- Vehicles are only permitted on designated roads and parking lots.
- Park in designated lots/areas only. Parking on vegetated road shoulders or in washes are prohibited.
- Parking is limited in the canyon; particularly during busy spring and fall periods or holidays. Your pass does not guarantee access; parking; or special privileges in the canyon. Lots that accommodate buses: Chuckwalla, Padre/Johnson Canyon, Sand Dunes Picnic, Campground, Upper Galoot Picnic, and Gila.
- Stay on designated trails and paved surfaces. As part of the Red Cliffs Desert Reserve, hiking is limited to designated, mapped trails only. Fee waivers do not grant special privileges. Refer to the park brochure for our trail system.
- You are responsible for the safety and behavior of your group.
- Do not modify park resources. This includes moving rocks; cutting or trimming plants; writing on rocks; etc.
- Respect wildlife. Wildlife will not be approached or handled, with the exception of a Mojave Desert Tortoise if found on the park road. Follow instructions on the back of our park brochure for safe, legal relocation.
- Drones are prohibited except with a pre-approved drone permit from the park.
- Dogs must be leashed and under control. Scoop, bag, and bin all dog waste.
- Educational activities will not limit or impede use by the general public.
- All activity is limited to park hours 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. No use will occur outside these hours.
- Passes, fee waivers, and scheduled visits are non-transferable.
