Camping at Coral Pink Sand Dunes State Park

Please observe the following park regulations to ensure everyone's visit is pleasant.

Loop 'A' is a 22-unit campground plus 1 group site and modern restrooms including showers. Each site is a paved pull-through with a picnic table, fire pit, cooking grill, and surrounding trees.

Loop 'B' has 12 sites with water, electric hookups, picnic tables, fire pits, and restrooms with vault toilets and showers.

Rules and Regulations:

- Camping fee is \$28.00 per camp unit (vehicle and trailer) (includes day-use fee and showers). Hook up sites are \$45.00 per camp unit (includes day-use fee and showers).
- Additional vehicle fee is \$20.00 per night and must be approved by park management. All vehicles must fit in campsite and have an extra vehicle tag. There is no overflow parking area.
- Do not park at bathroom or other sites as overflow.
- Checkout time is 2:00 pm Utah time.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am Utah time. No OHV use, generators or loud music, etc, during those hours.
- Camping loops are one way.
- Speed limit in campground is 5 mph.

- All household trash goes in the dumpsters at the dump station and at the vault toilet.
- Do not move rocks or park off asphalt except in designated areas. (Corrals)
- No fireworks are allowed in Utah State Parks.
- Pets must remain on a leash and never left unattended.
- Firewood collecting in the park is prohibited. Firewood may be purchased at the visitor center. Please use only water to put out campfires, not sand.
- Do not leave camper hoses connected to water faucets in loop 'A'.
- Please use the dump station located in your campground.
- Please be considerate of those around you.
- Do not wash any vehicles or fill pools due to park water consumption restrictions.
- Do not run extension cords from group site or use outlets from restroom building.
- The dump station is located just outside the entrance of the old campground and across from the new group site. Fresh drinking water is available. Non-campers may use the dump station for the \$15.00 day-use fee.
