The park managers in Utah are required under rule (R651-620-6) to have persons wanting to metal detect in their managed parks to have their patrons be permitted. - Review and sign this form of understanding.
- Metal detecting on beaches is permitted.
- Metal detecting on maintained grass areas and in the campground is **NOT** permitted.
- As per admin rule, R651-620-6 All property of value must be turn over to lost and found at the main office. Should you want any items please leave your contact information at the park office. After 60 days please contact us and should they not be claimed you may claim them.
- As you metal detect, we ask that you take any and all trash you find to the dumpster. We appreciate your efforts to keep parks clean. Please re-establish any area you disturb.
- Please be respectful of other guests and give them their space and time to enjoy their park opportunities as well.
- Lastly, have a great time.
